I agree to accept this responsibility for defense at the request of the City and also agree to defend and indemnify (with counsel of the City's choosing), and hold the City harmless from any costs, claims, demand, financial loss, penalties, fines, judgments, or liabilities arising from the approvals, with or without conditions, including without limitation, any award or attorney's fees that might result from the third party challenge, excepting only liability arising from the sole negligence, gross negligence, or intentional misconduct of City. For the purpose of this indemnity, the term "City" shall include the City of Agoura Hills, its officers, officials, employees, agents, and representatives. For the purpose of this indemnity, the term "challenge" means any legal or administrative action to dispute, contest, attack, set aside, limit, or modify the approval, project conditions, or any act upon which the approval is based, including, but not limited to, any action alleging a failure to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act or other laws.

Further, I consent that I am the legal owner of record of the land specified in this application or am authorized and empowered to act as an agent on behalf of the owner of record on all matters relating to this application. I declare that the foregoing is true and correct and accept that false or inaccurate owner authorization may invalidate or delay action on this application.

- * A tree permit is nontransferable and must be kept on site when any work described in the permit is taking place.
- * The permittee understands that when any work is completed it shall constitute an acceptance of the permit general provision.
- * Any person violating provisions of City of Agoura Hills Municipal Code is subject to a suspension of any permits until all mitigation measures specified by the City are satisfactory complete or the appropriate restitution, as determined by the City, has been made.

Administrative approvals. The department of planning and community development has jurisdiction to approve a request for the removal of one (1) oak tree on a single parcel. Except for dead trees, subsequent requests for the removal of trees beyond one (1) oak tree on a single parcel of record will be referred to the planning commission for review and approval.

Planning commission approval. When two (2) or more trees are being requested for removal on an original application, the case will be referred to the planning commission.

Oak tree permit approval process. The director of planning and community development or the planning commission may approve an oak tree permit when one (1) of the following findings can be made, after city inspection of the tree and property.

Appeals. Within twenty (20) calendar days of the notice of decision, the applicant, city council, or planning commission may appeal the decision of the director of planning and community development to the planning commission or the decision of the planning commission to the city council.

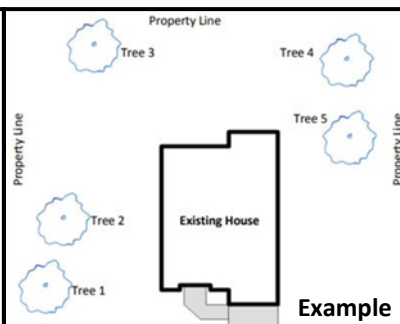
