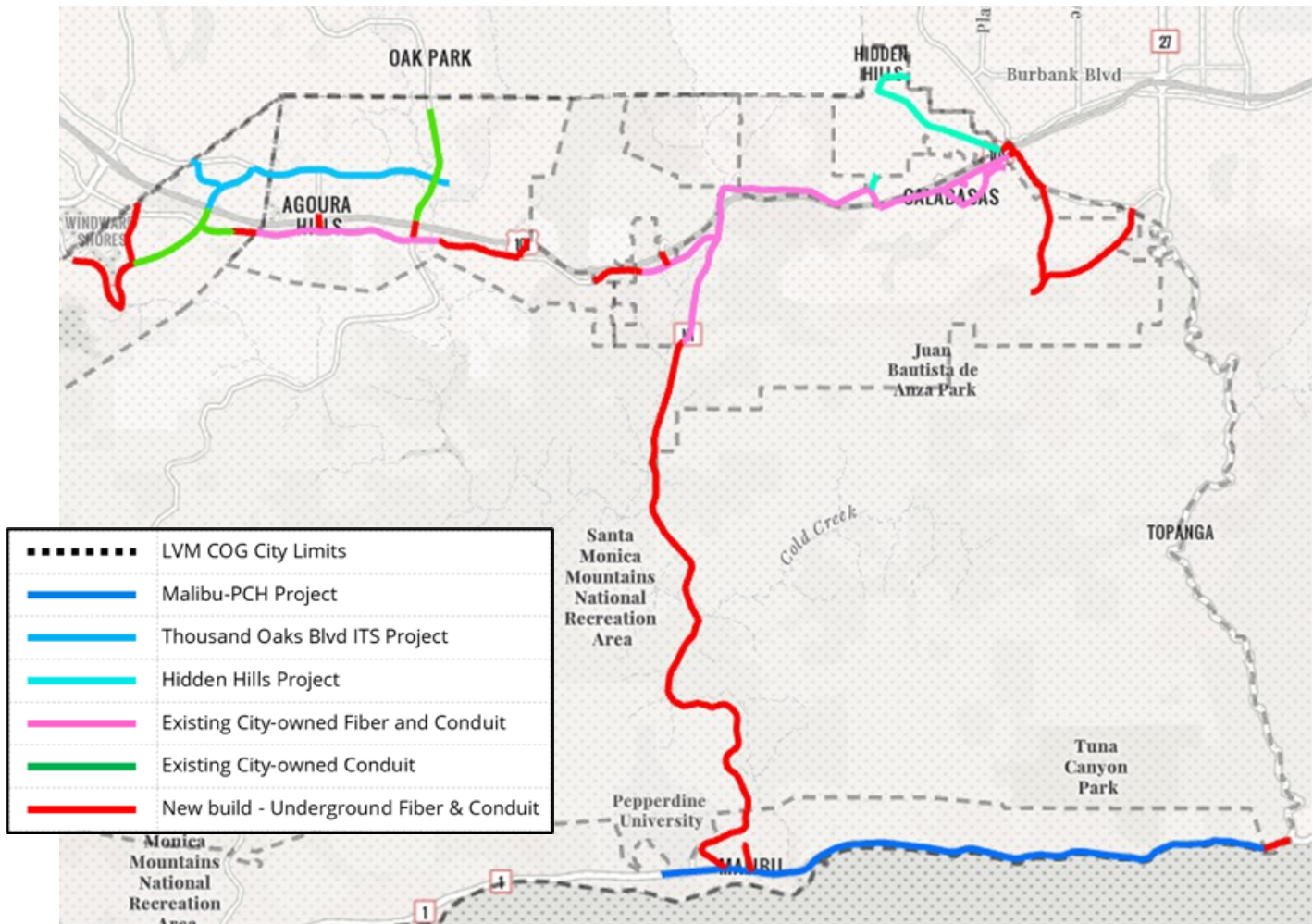




PLANNED PUBLIC FIBER OPTIC NETWORK



- The LVMCOG, consisting of Agoura Hills, Calabasas, Hidden Hills, Malibu, and Westlake Village, is building a 45-mile fiber optic network.
- The network will connect each City Hall, facilitate communication for public agencies (water, fire, sheriff, schools) and coordinate and control the region’s traffic signals.
- The project is funded by Los Angeles County Measure M funds.
- The LVMCOG aims to leverage this public network to offer competitive, reliable retail data services to the community and businesses by partnering with an experienced ISP.
- The final design of the network will be completed in October. Construction is anticipated to begin in early 2025.
