REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBERS 06-334 AND 06-335

On May 9, 2007, the City Council held first reading and introduced Ordinance No. 07-345.

In accordance with the court order to set aside certification of the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and approval of the Agoura Village Specific Plan (AVSP) pending certain updated biological studies and text changes, the Ordinance repeals Ordinance Numbers 06-334 and 06-335.

Ordinance No. 06-334 is a zoning map change to designate all properties in the AVSP area to the "Specific Plan" designation and Ordinance No. 06-335 amends language in the Zoning Ordinance to reference the "Specific Plan" designation.
