SUBJECT: ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 07-344; AN ORDINANCE OF THE

CITY COUNCIL OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 9708.3 OF THE AGOURA HILLS MUNICPAL CODE RELATING TO THE RECONSTRUCTION OF NON-CONFORMING

**DAMAGED BUILDINGS** 

At the City Council meeting of May 23, 2007, the Council introduced, read by title only, and waived further reading of Ordinance No. 07-344.

This ordinance amends the threshold for reconstruction of non-conforming damaged buildings. The existing ordinance, which was adopted under urgency, is repealed and new criteria are established. These criteria include a 50% reconstruction threshold for all non-residential structures. Only residential structures and four non-conforming, non-residential structures already identified as historic, are exempted.

## RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council adopt Ordinance No. 07-344.
