

RESOLUTION NO. 07-1458

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, MODIFYING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON BOTH SIDES OF ROADSIDE DRIVE EAST SIDE OF ROADSIDE ROAD

WHEREAS, public concern has been expressed for the need to prevent vehicles from stopping along Roadside Drive, east of Roadside Road to the cul-de-sac; and

WHEREAS, the City's Traffic Engineer has determined that the existing paved roadway is only wide enough for a travel lane in each direction; with no additional room for stopping along the curb; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Traffic Engineer is recommending that "No Stopping Any Time" signs be installed to mitigate these concerns; and,

WHEREAS, Section 22507 of the California Vehicle Code permits local authorities to restrict parking on streets under their jurisdiction; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Agoura Hills adopt Resolution No. 07-1458, establishing "No Stopping Any Time" restrictions along both sides of Roadside Drive, east of Roadside Road to the cul-de-sac.
