



## Administration Options /Cost

### Option 1 (Permit Current Newsrack Inventory)

#### Advantages

- Liability for Newsrack – Vendor Responsibility
- Maintenance Cost – Vendor Responsibility
- Replacement Cost – Vendor Responsibility

#### Disadvantages

- No Uniformity in Appearance (Aesthetics)
- Maintenance Requires Consistent Inspections for Compliance Monitoring
- Violations of Maintenance/Operation Standards Require Notification for Correction (More intensive administration work)

Estimated Program Cost:

City Staffing	\$ 7,794
Contract Staffing (LA County Rack Removal: 31 racks)	\$ 2,722
Potential Disposal Cost (Old Newsracks)	\$ 85
<b>Total Estimated Cost</b>	<b>\$10,601</b>

### Option 2 (Establish City Owned Newsrack System)

#### Advantages

- Uniform Aesthetic Appearance
- Quicker Response to Maintenance Issues (Establish Maintenance Schedule)
- Less Administrative Time Expended Addressing Maintenance/Operation Standards

#### Disadvantages

- One Time Capital Expensive for Purchase of Newsrack System
- City Assumes Liability for Newsrack (Currently vendor assumes)
- City Assumes Maintenance & Replacement Cost for newsracks (Currently vendor assumes)

Estimated Program Costs:

One Time capital Expense: (Newsrack system)	\$20,000
System Installation (Contracted)	\$10,000
Administration (City staff)	\$ 2,808
Contract Staffing (LA County Rack Removal: 113 racks)	\$10,206
Potential Disposal Cost (Old Newsracks)	\$ 566
<b>Total Estimated Cost</b>	<b>\$43,580</b>
