

RESOLUTION NO. 07-1466

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, IMPLEMENTING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH SIDE OF PASSAGEWAY PLACE BETWEEN REYES ADOBE ROAD AND 70 FEET WEST OF REYES ADOBE ROAD

WHEREAS, public concern has been expressed for the need to establish a parking policy that prohibits vehicles from being parked in locations that create line-of-sight problems

WHEREAS, Section 22507 of the California Vehicle Code permits local authorities to restrict parking on streets under their jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, the City’s Traffic Engineer has determined there is a need to implement a parking policy to prevent vehicles from parking anytime which creates line-of-sight; and,

WHEREAS, the City’s Traffic Engineer is recommending that “No Parking Anytime” signs be installed to mitigate the public’s concerns; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Agoura Hills adopts Resolution No. 07-1466, establishing “No Parking Anytime” restrictions on the north and south side of Passageway Place, between Reyes Adobe Road and 70 feet west of Reyes Adobe Road.
