SUBJECT: APPROVE THE INSTALLATION OF “NO PARKING ANYTIME” SIGNS, AND ADOPT RESOLUTION NO. 07-1466, IMPLEMENTING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH SIDE OF PASSAGEWAY PLACE, BETWEEN REYES ADOBE ROAD TO 70 FEET WEST OF REYES ADOBE ROAD

Public concerns have recently been expressed about the number of vehicles that have been parking along the north and south side of Passageway Place, between Reyes Adobe Road and Jon Dodson Drive. This is a short stretch of roadway and vehicles park close to the corners of Passageway Place and Reyes Adobe Road, creating a line-of-sight issue for drivers.

In light of this, the City’s Traffic Engineer recommends the installation of “No Parking Anytime” signs along the north and south side of Passageway Place to restrict parking, between Reyes Adobe Road and 70 feet west of Reyes Adobe Road. This will ensure that parked cars are not obstructing the views of motorists and that a driver’s safety is not compromised at this intersection.

With City Council approval, new regulatory signs would be installed by the Los Angeles County Public Works Department within four weeks. In addition, the Lost Hills Sheriff’s Traffic Division will be notified of the changes, allowing for immediate enforcement of the new restrictions.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council approve the installation of “No Parking Anytime” signs, and adopt Resolution No. 07-1466, which will cause the implementation of the new parking restrictions along Passageway Place, between Reyes Adobe Road and Jon Dodson Drive.
