

RESOLUTION NO. 07-1468

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, IMPLEMENTING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON THE WEST SIDE OF MIDDLE CREST DRIVE BETWEEN THOUSAND OAKS BOULEVARD AND 20 FEET SOUTH OF THOUSAND OAKS BOULEVARD

WHEREAS, public safety concerns have been expressed for the need to establish a parking policy that prohibits parked vehicles from creating line-of-sight problems; and,

WHEREAS, Section 22507 of the California Vehicle Code permits local authorities to restrict parking on streets under their jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Traffic Engineer has determined there is a line-of-site problem along Middle Crest Drive, between Thousand Oaks Boulevard and 20 feet south of Thousand Oaks Boulevard, and thus a need to restrict vehicles from parking any time along this portion of roadway to maintain clear line-of-sight; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Traffic Engineer is recommending that 20-feet of red curb be installed along the west side of Middle Crest Drive, between Thousand Oaks Boulevard and 20-feet south of Thousand Oaks Boulevard to maintain line-of-sight; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Agoura Hills adopts Resolution No. 07-1468, establishing parking restrictions on the west side of Middle Crest Drive by installing red curbing between Thousand Oaks Boulevard and 20 feet south of Thousand Oaks Boulevard.
