Staff is requesting the selection of Planning Commission members to serve on the following City committees during the 2008 calendar year:

Art in Public Places Committee: (1 Commissioner) General Plan Advisory Committee: (2 Commissioners) Agoura Village Policy Committee: (2 Commissioners)

The Art in Public Places Committee consists of one Planning Commissioner, two City Council Members (Council Members Kuperberg and Schwarz) and the Director of Planning and Community Development. The Committee meets on an as-needed basis to review and select public art proposals required for large development projects. The Committee generally meets four to five times per year, depending on the number and frequency of proposals submitted for review. Commissioner Buckley Weber served on the Committee in 2007.

The General Plan Advisory Committee (GPAC) provides recommendations to the Planning Commission and City Council for the General Plan. The Committee includes Mayor Pro Tem Weber and Council Member Schwarz, and appointed City residents. The GPAC meets on an asneeded basis. As we enter the third phase of the General Plan Update, it is anticipated that the GPAC will meet approximately once each month. Vice Chair Zacuto and Commissioner Ramuno served on the Committee in 2007.

Staff is also requesting the appointment of two (2) Planning Commissioners to serve on the Agoura Village Policy Committee during the 2008 calendar year. The Committee, which includes Mayor Edelston and Council Member Koehler, will advise staff on policy issues related to the processing of pending development applications within the Agoura Village Specific Plan area. The committee will meet on an as-needed basis, however staff anticipates that approximately 4-5 meetings will be held this year. Chair Rishoff and Commissioner O'Meara served on the Committee in 2007.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Planning Commission select the 2008 calendar year committee appointments.
