**SUBJECT: APPROVE APPOINTMENTS TO THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS**

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The Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) is scheduled to hold its General Assembly, where member cities and counties meet for purposes of conducting their annual business, at the Ontario Convention Center on Thursday, May 8, 2008.

Consistent with SCAG's bylaws, member cities are required to submit the names of one official representative (delegate) and one alternate who are eligible to vote for the new Board President and participate in discussion at the General Assembly.

Appointments of one official representative (mayor) and one alternate (member of the legislative body) are required to be submitted to SCAG, prior to the General Assembly, and are to occur during a meeting of the City Council with the minutes recording the action.

Upon approval of the recommended appointments, the City Clerk will forward a copy of the minute motion to the Southern California Association of Governments.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council approve the following appointments and direct the City Clerk to file the appropriate documents with the Southern California Association of Governments:

Alternate: Denis Weber, Mayor Pro Tem
