SUBJECT: CONDUCT A PRE-SCREEN REVIEW OF ZONING ORDINANCE

AMENDMENTS REGARDING ON-SITE AND OFF-SITE SALES OF

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES (CASE NO. 09-PSR-002)

As part of last year's budget workshop, the City Council directed staff to prepare a special study for the purpose of exploring options for further regulating businesses that sell or serve alcoholic beverages. Staff has met with the Economic Development Committee (EDC) on two occasions to review options for regulating those businesses. The purpose of this pre-screen review is to seek direction on whether to pursue zoning ordinance amendments.

Currently, the City allows a number of uses (bar, café, restaurant, liquor store, etc.) that sell or serve alcoholic beverages as a use allowed by right in certain zones. As long as these businesses conform to zoning code and building code regulations, they may operate without a Conditional Use Permit. As shown in the attached Table 1, every other city in the surrounding region, as well as the Counties of Los Angeles and Ventura, require that such businesses obtain approval of a Conditional Use Permit. This allows these jurisdictions to review the physical, as well as operational, standards of a proposed business, and, on a case-by-case basis, apply appropriate conditions to ensure neighborhood compatibility and the public welfare is protected.

The State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) issues licenses to manage the sale of alcohol. The number of licenses is limited, based on population within each census tract. The ABC enforces state laws, such as the age of purchase, and server responsibility. There are two main types of licenses: on-sale licenses are for businesses that serve alcohol for consumption on site, such as bars or restaurants; off-sale licenses are for businesses that serve alcohol for consumption off the site, such as grocery stores, convenience stores, and liquor stores.

Looking at ways to control nuisance type issues, such as noise, related to the proximity of businesses that sell alcoholic beverages to residential areas, as well as overall safety issues related to the concentration of such businesses, the EDC asked that zoning controls be explored for both on-sale and off-sale businesses. The discussion focused on which businesses should be covered, and how the issues should be addressed.

The Committee reviewed the list of licenses for existing businesses that sell alcoholic beverages issued by the State (attached Tables 2 and 3) and it was decided that each business had the potential to impact either the neighborhood, or the City as a whole, depending on its location and how it operated. The option to cover all businesses that sell or serve alcoholic beverages would ensure the greatest level of protection for the City.

Again, looking at the list of existing licensees in the City, a wide variety could be seen in the types of businesses and how they operated. Given this variety, the EDC felt that instead of prescribing specific standards for development and performance, the Conditional Use Permit process provided the flexibility to address potential concerns associated with each application.

In addition, a Conditional Use Permit would allow the public an opportunity to voice any concerns prior to a business being established. The Planning Commission could then, based on the specific circumstances, apply appropriate conditions to ensure the neighborhood would not be impacted by the proposed use. Conditions related to the overall operation of the business, including security provisions and hours of operation, could help reduce the potential for public health and safety impacts. This would also address businesses that serve alcohol and have live entertainment.

General performance standards can be created to make sure the design and operation of these uses meets community standards. A Conditional Use Permit process also allows review of applications on a case-by-case basis, allowing conditions to be tailored to the circumstances. It also provides for local control that can better and more quickly respond to a variety of issues that are not addressed by the State Alcohol Beverage Control Department.

In summary, the EDC recommended that the Zoning Ordinance be amended to require a Conditional Use Permit for both on-sale and off-sale establishments, that separate findings be required for each category, and that these findings be general and performance based. The EDC also recommended that existing establishments be subject to the new Conditional Use Permit requirements when they expand or intensify by a certain amount or change their license category.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff seeks direction from the City Council on whether to initiate a zoning ordinance amendment to require a Conditional Use Permit for businesses that sell or serve alcoholic beverages.
