

NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS
FOR THE JOINT CITY
PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROGRAM 2009

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Westlake Village as AGENCY, invites sealed bids for the above stated project and will receive such bids in the office of the City Clerk, 31200 Oak Crest Drive, Westlake Village, California 91361, up to the hour of **10:00 a.m. on April 9, 2009**, at which time they will be publicly opened. Copies of the Contract Documents and Specifications are available from the AGENCY, 31200 Oak Crest Drive, Westlake Village, California 91361 upon payment of a \$35.00 non-refundable fee if picked up, or payment of a \$45.00 non-refundable fee, if mailed.

Any contract entered into pursuant to this notice will incorporate the provisions of the State Labor Code. Compliance with the prevailing rates of wages and apprenticeship employment standards established by the State Director of Industrial Relations will be required. Affirmative action to ensure against discrimination in employment practices on the basis of race, color, national origin, ancestry, sex, or religion will also be required. The AGENCY hereby affirmatively ensures that all business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this notice and will not be discriminated against on the basis of race, color, national origin, ancestry, sex, or religion in any consideration leading to the award of contract.

Bids must be prepared on the approved Proposal forms in conformance with the Instructions to Bidders and submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked on the outside, **"SEALED BID FOR THE JOINT CITY PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROGRAM 2009, DO NOT OPEN WITH REGULAR MAIL"**. The bid must be accompanied by certified or cashier's check, or bidder's bond, made payable to the AGENCY. The bid guaranty shall be an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total maximum amount bid with their proposals as required by California law.

The contract will not be awarded to a bidder who does not hold a valid Class "A" license in accordance with the provisions of the Business and Professions Code. The AGENCY reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularity, and to take all bids under advisement for a period of forty-five days.
