

WHAT IS GRASSCYCLING???

Your lawn and your grass catcher don't make such a great couple after all!!!

And when you grasscycle during the spring and summer months, you can reduce the added expense of organic fertilizers.

Grasscycling has overriding environmental benefits too. Like conserving water, and conserving limited landfill space. (Where do you think all those plastic bags of grass are going anyway?) And, if you go the extra yard and pop for an electric mulching mower, you'll also reduce gas fume pollution and eliminate the need to recycle motor oil.
