construct a 2,685 square-foot, two-story residence and a 491 square-foot, attached, two-car garage; a request for a Variance from Zoning Ordinance Sections 9243.3.F and 9606.2.A. to provide 18-foot combined side yards instead of the minimum 22 feet and to construct retaining walls in excess of 3.5 feet

in height in the front yard area.

construction.
