SUBJECT: ADOPT ORDINANCE NO. 09-366; AMENDING PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR PREFERENTIAL PARKING DISTRICT NO. 2 IN THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY TRAFFIC CODE AND AMENDING THE AGOURA HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE

At the August 12, 2009 City Council meeting, the Council introduced, read by title only, and waived further reading of Ordinance No. 09-366. The ordinance will amend the Municipal Code, by removing the existing “No Parking” signs along Conejo View Drive, between Driver Avenue and 170-feet south of Driver Avenue, and replacing them with “No Stopping” signs.

The City Council approved the ordinance amendment and resolution by a 5-0 vote.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the City Council adopt Ordinance No. 09-366 regarding the modification of the existing parking restrictions on Conejo View Drive, amending the Agoura Hills Municipal Code.

ORDINANCE NO. 09-366

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR PREFERENTIAL PARKING DISTRICT NO. 2 IN THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY TRAFFIC CODE AND AMENDING THE AGOURA HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 15.64.765 of Title 15 of Division 1 of the Traffic Code of the Los Angeles County Code, as amended and in effect on April 1, 1983, as amended in Section 3204 of Chapter 2 of Article III of the Agoura Hills Municipal Code is hereby further amended to read as follows:

“15.64.765 *Agoura Hills Preferential Parking District No. 2, parking restriction.*

All vehicles are prohibited from stopping on both sides of Conejo View Drive, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on school days, from Driver Avenue to 170-feet south of Driver Avenue. Vehicles displaying residential or guest preferential permits may park during all other times along this segment.

Parking is prohibited along Conejo View Drive, between 170-feet south of Driver and Argos Street, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on school days, except for those vehicles displaying residential or guest preferential parking permits.”
