INTERGOVERNMENTAL, SPECIAL PURPOSE COMMITTEE, & DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

Director of Community Services Amy Brink spoke about AEG Cycling conducting the upcoming Amgen Tour of California multi-stage cycling race in May 2010; explained that the tour was an international event that brings an increase in tourism, sales tax, TOT, and visitor exposure to host cities; noted that a letter of intent was signed by the cities of Agoura Hills, Thousand Oaks, and Westlake Village to host the start and finish of the last stage of the race; and
