SUBJECT: Upcoming Committee Appointments

The purpose of this memorandum is to advise the Planning Commission that staff will place a discussion item on the February 2, 2006 Planning Commission Meeting agenda regarding the 2006 calendar year committee appointments. Staff will be requesting the selection of Planning Commission members to serve on the following City committees:

Art in Public Places Committee: (1 Commissioner)

Agoura Village Task Force Committee: (2 Commissioners) General Plan Advisory Committee: (2 Commissioners)

The Art in Public Places Committee consists of one Planning Commissioner, two City Council Members (Mayor Weber and Council Member Schwarz) and the Director of Planning and Community Development. The Committee meets on an as-needed basis to review and select public art proposals required for large development projects. The Committee generally meets five times per year, depending on the number and frequency of proposals submitted for review.

The responsibility of the Agoura Village Task Force Committee is to provide recommendations to the City Council on the implementation of the Agoura Village Specific Plan, which will soon be considered for adoption by the City Council. Mayor Pro Tem Kuperberg and Council Member Koehler, as well as selected business and property owners, currently serve on the Committee. Vice Chair Ramuno and Commissioner Zacuto were selected to serve on the Committee in 2005. The Committee will meet on an as-needed basis.

The General Plan Advisory Committee provides recommendations to the Planning Commission and City Council for revisions currently being considered to the Land Use and Circulation Elements of the General Plan. The Committee includes Mayor Weber, Council Member Schwarz and appointed City residents and meets on an as-needed basis, but generally once every 2-3 months. Commissioner Zacuto served on the Committee in 2005.

RECOMMENDATION

No action is requested at this time. Staff recommends that the Planning Commission confirm the 2005 calendar year committee appointments at their meeting of February 2, 2006.
