**SUBJECT: NOTICE OF COMPLETION FOR THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL (EMERGENCY) BATTERY BACK UP PROJECT; NIB 10-02**

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The City contracted with Traffic Development Construction Services (TDS) to furnish and install battery backup units for seven locations in the City of Agoura Hills. However, prior to the official award of the contract, the traffic signal at Reyes Adobe Road and Thousand Oaks Boulevard began malfunctioning and so staff had to immediately install a battery back-up unit at this specific location. Because the contract was not in place at the time, the Los Angeles County Public Works Signal Maintenance Division completed the one installation, and TDS' scope was revised from seven installations to six.

On May 17, 2010, the City Council awarded the contract to Traffic Development Construction Services (TDS) to install battery backup units for six locations in the City of Agoura Hills. On June 29, 2010, the work was completed in full to the City's satisfaction. The total cost of the project was \$28,718.00. The project was completed within budget and paid for entirely using Proposition C funds.

The City now has all traffic signals equipped with battery backup units

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends the City Council approve, and accept as complete, the work of Traffic Development Construction Services (TDS) for the installation of six battery backup units as part of the Traffic Signal (Emergency) Battery Back Up Project; NIB 10-02.
