

**MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING OF THE

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Conduct a Public Hearing and Adopt **Resolution No. 06-1427**; A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, FINDING THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS TO BE IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE CONGESTION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (CMP) AND ADOPTING THE CMP LOCAL DEVELOPMENT REPORT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 65089

Introduce, Read by Title Only, and Waive Further Reading of **Ordinance No. 06-337**; AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING ARTICLE III, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 3300, ANIMAL CONTROL REGULATIONS, OF THE AGOURA HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE, AND ADDING MANDATORY SPAY/NEUTERING AND MICROCHIPPING FOR ALL DOGS

ACTION: Following presentation of the staff report, the motion by Councilmember Schwarz, to introduce, read by title only, and waive further reading of Ordinance No. 06-337, was seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Kuperberg, and approved on a roll call vote of 5-0.

City Engineer Ken Berkman announced that the street sweeping schedule was amended, so as not to conflict with trash collection days, and the new schedule would be implemented in September.

Mayor Pro Tem Kuperberg congratulated Nathan Hamburger on his Father's (Steve Hamburger) 30-year anniversary with the County of Los Angeles, in the Department of Health Services, and on his award as Employee of the Month.
