BUDGET WORKSHOP - COMMUNITY OUTREACH GRANTS

The Community Outreach Grant Program has completed the application cycle for Fiscal Year 2011-12 and 18 applications, of which three were new applicants, were received. The applications were reviewed by the Finance Committee on May 25, 2011. The funding requests totaled \$53,619. Due to the unprecedented economic situation that the nation is facing and the large uncertainty as to whether or not the Redevelopment Agencies will remain intact as they exist today, which could have significant financial impacts on the City's General Fund, the Finance Committee tried to come up with a reasonable but conservative approach to assisting the applicants. In an effort to keep the budget presented to the City Council for approval balanced, it is recommended that not more than \$10,000 in grant funding be awarded. The Finance Committee's proposed funding recommendations of \$9,600 are attached for discussion by the City Council.

All grant applications were received within the allotted application period, including the required paperwork and back up information.

RECOMMENDATION

It is respectfully recommended the City Council review the information presented and provide direction to staff.
