SUBJECT: CONTRACT AWARD FOR THE KANAN-CANWOOD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT - NIB 11-01

On April 27, 2011, the City Council authorized staff to seek bids for the Kanan-Canwood Intersection Improvement Project, NIB 11-01. The scope of work for the bid includes modifying the left-turn pocket to allow for extension of dual left-turn lanes, increasing storage capacity of the southbound left-turn movement; removal of existing, interfering vegetation; and replacing irrigation line and sprinkler heads. The scope also includes modifications and adjustments to the traffic signal, allowing additional time for dual left-turn movements and other safety measures at Kanan Road and the easterly leg of Canwood Street intersection.

On May 19, 2011, the City Clerk opened sealed bids from five (5) contractors. The bid results were as follows:

Staff reviewed the bid submittal of the apparent low bidder, West Coast Public Work, Inc. and deemed their bid responsive and acceptable. Since West Coast Public Work, Inc. has never worked in the City, staff contacted all their listed references. The responses were positive, with all references stating that they would work with West Coast Public Work, Inc. again.

The project will be paid for entirely with RDA bond funds. Staff expects construction to commence in June, taking approximately forty-five (45) calendar days to complete thereafter.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council:

1. Award the contract for the Kanan-Canwood Intersection Improvement Project (NIB 11-01) to West Coast Public Work, Inc.
2. Authorize the Mayor to sign the contract agreement.
